## RULES & REGULATIONS

- Entries are allowed from Nacogdoches County Residents Only.
- Entries previously submitted in the Pineywoods Fair Project Show are not eligible, including but not limited to entries including additions and/or revisions of previously entered projects and new projects that include major parts from previously entered projects. If it is additions and/or revisions of previously entered projects, it must be shown as in restoration-Repurpose Division.
- All entries must have been completed after the 2021 Pineywoods Fair. All entries must be certified and under supervision of Ag Teacher or County Extension Agent prior to the show. Entries are due Friday October 7th, 2022.
- There will be seven (7) Divisions in which projects may be entered:
  - Livestock Equipment and Agricultural Machinery
  - Home and Yard -Metal (Any project which contains structural metal framework)
  - Home and Yard- Wood (Must be built completely out of wood other than décor/brackets/hinges)
  - BBQ Pits and Smokers
  - Wildlife
  - Trailers - Single Axle, Tandem Axle
  - Restoration - Repurpose
- Projects will be judged on points:
 

A) Workmanship	30	D) Practical Utility	15
B) Sound Structural Design & Balance	25	E) Originality	5
C) Degree of Difficulty	20	F) Appropriate Finish	5
- FFA or 4-H Show Cards must be on each exhibit showing the name or names of the students who built the project and the name of the chapter. All names on projects will be removed during judging.
- If the project is for sale a minimum price must be exhibited.
- Projects will be placed in each division 1st - 5th Place. Blue & Red Ribbon items will be sold at auction Saturday, October 15, 2022 at 3:00 P.M. 1st Place plaques will be awarded in each division at the beginning of the auction on Saturday. Blue, Red, and White Ribbons will be awarded to all other exhibitors entered at the completion of judging. In the case of a tie, the judge will make the final tie-breaking decision. The judges decision is final.
- All projects must remain on the grounds until conclusion of the Ag Mechanics Auction on Saturday. Any project that leaves prior to this will forfeit all placings and/or sweepstakes points for that entry.

### Grand & Reserve Overall Projects

Two Judge Panel to consist of 1 Ag Teacher & 1 Industry Representative

--SWEEPSTAKES AWARD--

A Sweepstakes Award will be given to the FFA Chapter or 4-H Group scoring the most points. Determination of the Sweepstakes Winner will be made by the following formula:

Five (5) points for 1st Place	Four (4) points for 2nd Place	Three (3) points for 3rd Place
Two (2) points for 4th Place	One (1) point for 5th Place	

Total points will be added, then divided by the total number of projects placed plus one.

The Chapter or Club with the highest score will be the Sweepstakes Winner.

(You must enter one project in at least five (5) of the six (7) divisions to be eligible for the Sweepstakes Award.)
